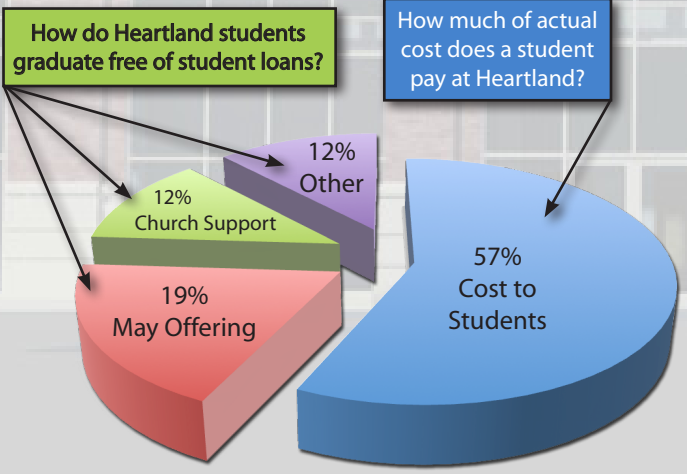

Many believe that a high cost of education equals a high quality education. Actually, high cost may reflect high operating costs (debts, salaries, low support base); however, Heartland Baptist Bible College is one of the most affordable independent fundamental Baptist colleges in the country with a faculty and staff that is committed to the highest standard of excellence in educating and training preachers, missionaries and Christian workers. What makes us so affordable is how God has blessed this college with over 350 churches that give monthly support and also participate in the annual May College Project Offering. These two avenues of support underwrite approximately 31% of the school's operating costs; or to put it another way, this support gives every student a 31% scholarship that directly reduces the amount they will be required to pay. Bookstore sales and Music Group CD sales underwrite an additional 12% leaving the students to pay only 57% of the total educational cost. This level of support is what makes it possible to only charge each student approximately \$7,050 for one year of tuition, room, board, and fees which ultimately gives every Heartland student the opportunity to graduate free of student loans.
